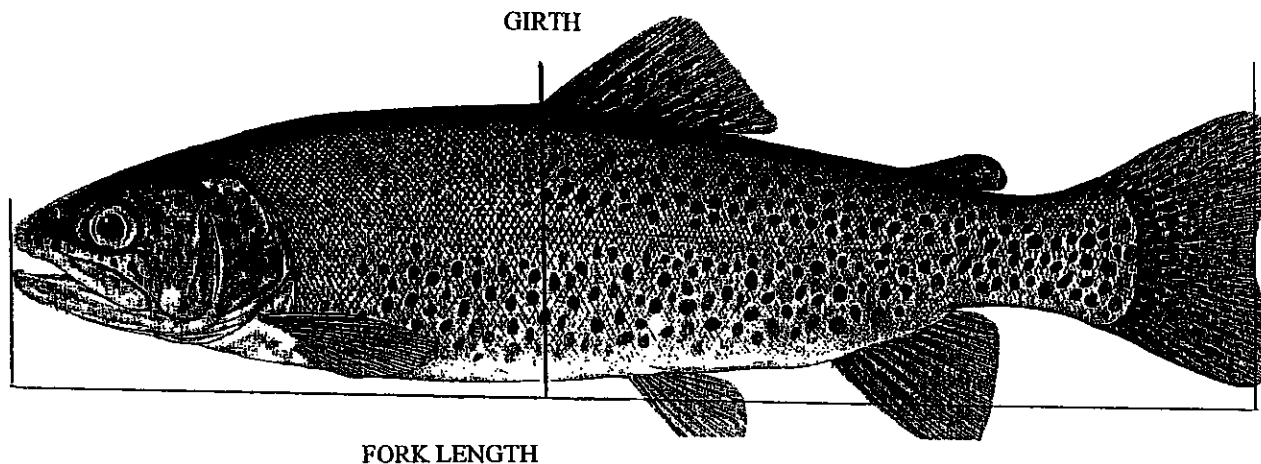




Information from Upper Rogue Trout Anglers Requested

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife is conducting a study to estimate weight of trout in the Upper Rogue Basin.



FOR TROUT CAUGHT IN ROGUE RIVER TRIBUTARIES ABOVE LOST CR. RESERVOIR

1. Measure the Fork Length of each landed fish, preferably in millimeters. If measuring in inches, measure to nearest 1/8th of an inch.
2. Measure the girth of each fish just anterior of the dorsal fin.
3. Record date, species, stream, and approximate location (we don't need to know your secret spots)
4. Turn in data to:

Estimate trout weights on your own:

- Metric Units (millimeters and grams): $\text{Weight} = (\text{Fork Length} \times \text{Girth}^2) / 26918$
- English Units (inches and pounds): $\text{Weight} = (\text{Fork Length} \times \text{Girth}^2) / 812$
